- Družbeni položaj posameznikov nekoč in danes.

Content (Syllabus outline):

- Defining the key concepts; society, individual in a society, Slovenian society in the global perspective, contemporary social problems (unemployment, family, addiction, fertility/mortality);
- Society's functional subsystems - selected examples: economics, politics and the public sphere, family, education, religion;
- Knowledge of developmental indicators of Slovenian society (in comparative perspective - the world);
- Statistical data about the crucial issues in contemporary society (in comparative perspective - the world);
- Social standard in the past and nowadays.

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Predvideni študijski rezultati:

- razlike/spremembe med patriarhalno, modern in postomoderno (potrošniško) družbo;
- ključne spremembe in premiki v družbi (socializacija, vzgoja, vedenje, morala, družina, spol);
- hierarhične in funkcionalne delitve v družbi, ključne lastnosti posamičnih hierarhičnih in funkcionalnih družbenih enot, njihove medsebojne delitve, povezanosti in prepletosti;
- kritična refleksija in uporaba uradnih statistik ter izsledkov empiričnih družboslovnih raziskav, ki se nanašajo na sodobno družbo

Intended learning outcomes:

Knowledge and understanding of:

- fundamental/basic sociological/social concepts related to organization and functioning of contemporary society and their application to social changes;
- fundamental characteristics of Slovenian society and its placement in the European and global context;
- differences/changes between patriarchal, modern and post-modern (consumer) society;
- key changes and shifts in society (socialization, education, behaviour, moral, family, gender);
- hierarchical and functional divisions in society, key characteristics of hierarchical and functional social units, their mutual division, connections and intertwining;
- critical reflection and the use of official statistics and results of empirical social science research/findings relating to society
