Cilji in kompetence:

Cilji: ponuditi študentom in študentkam uveden predmet s področja varnosti ter jih seznaniti s ključnimi teoretičnimi in praktičnimi vidiki varnosti v mednarodnih odnosih in odnosi varnostnega sektorja z družbo. Predmet bo poskušal razviti tudi kritično zavedanje o aktualnih konfliktih ter ostalih dimenzijah sodobne varnosti, na katero močno vplivajo transnacionalne grožnje in vse hitrejši razvoj informacijske tehnologije.

Splošne kompetence:

- poznavanje in razumevanje kulturnih in družbenih procesov in sposobnost njihove kompleksne analize;
- uporaba metodoloških orodij, tj. izvajanje, koordiniranje in organiziranje raziskav, uporaba raznih raziskovalnih metod in tehnik;
- etična refleksija in zavezanost profesionalni etiki v družbenem okolju s spoštovanjem načela neskrinimatornosti in multikulturalnosti;
- razvoj komunikacijskih sposobnosti in spremnosti za komuniciranje z različnimi okolji;
- sposobnost timskega dela, tj. pripravljenost na sodelovanje, kooperativnost, upoštevanje mnenj drugih in izpolnjevanje dogovorjene vloge v okviru tima in skupine;
- sposobnost uporabe relevantnih domačih in mednarodnih virov, uporabe elektronskih virov in kritične analize relevantne literature;

Objectives and competences:

Objectives: Offer the students an introductory course on security and introduce them with the key theoretical and practical aspects of the security in the international relations and relations between security sector and the society. The course will also attempt to develop a critical awareness of current conflicts and other dimensions of contemporary security, which are strongly influenced by transnational threats and the increasingly rapid development of information technology.

- The application of methodological tools, i.e. implementation, coordination and organization of the research, the application of different research methods and techniques;
- Ethical reflection and commitment to professional ethics in the social environment with respect for the principles of non-discrimination and multiculturalism;
- The development of communication skills and skills for communicating with different environments;
- The ability for teamwork, i.e. willingness for cooperation, collaboration, taking into account the opinions of others and fulfilment of the defined roles within the team and the group;

- Understand the basics of civil-military relations, especially the importance of democratic oversight of the security sector;
- Knows the basics of intelligence activities in the information age;
- Knows and understands the importance and interdependence of the rule of law and the security;
- Knows and understands the importance of good governance for the security of the country, the region or the (globalized) society;

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Metode poučevanja in učenja:

- predavanja z aktivno udeležbo študentov (razlaga, diskusija, vprašanja, primeri);
- seminarske vaje (refleksija izkušenj, projektno delo, timsko delo, metode kritičnega mišljenja, diskusija, sporočanje povratne informacije, forum za reševanje kulturnih problemov, sporov, konfliktov in dilem, socialne igre);
- individualne in skupinske konzultacije (diskusija, dodatna razlaga, obravnava specifičnih vprašanj);
- samostojen študij (motiviranje, usmerjanje, samoopazovanje, samouravnavanje, refleksija, samoocenjevanje);
