Cilji in kompetence:

Cilj predmeta je študentom približati psihološko prvo pomoč v kriznem stresnem dogodku ter jih prek tega naučiti principov nudenja psihološke prve pomoči.

Objectives and competences:

The aim of the course is to bring students closer to psychological first aid in a crisis stressful event and through them to teach them the principles of providing psychological first aid.

- knowledge and understanding of basic concepts and methods, familiarity with innovations in the field of study,
- sensitivity to diversity and social inequality,
- ethical self-reflection and commitment to professional ethics,

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Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Znanje in razumevanje:

Študent/ka:

- izpelje krizno interenco v sklopu individualne ali skupinske svetovalne obravnave,
- dela ustrezne (krizne) interrence in obvladati ustrezno zaključevanje procesa,
- konstruktivno sodeluje z drugimi v procesu soustvarjanja možnih (želenih) rešitev,
- kritično in konsistentno reflektirasvoje funkcioniranje v procesu psihosocialne pomoči za izboljšavo svoje prakse,
- obvladuje osnove učinkovitega medosebnega komuniciranja, verbalnega in neverbalnega,
- zaveda se etične in profesionalne odgovornosti biti psihosocialni svetovalec,
- zaveda se problemov meja, vključujuč zaupnosti, v specifičnih situacijah.

Intended learning outcomes:

Knowledge and understanding:

Student:

- performs (crisis) intervention and know about the appropriate finishing process,
- carries out crisis interventions in the context of individual or group counselling treatment,
- constructively cooperates with others in the process of co-creation potential (desired) solution,
- critically and consistently reflects their functioning in the process of psychosocial support to improve their practices,
- masters the basics of efficient interpersonal communication, verbal and non-verbal,
- is aware of the ethical and professional responsibility of being a psychosocial counsellor,
- is aware of the problems of the borders, including confidentiality, in specific situations.

Metode poučevanja in učenja:

- predavanja z aktivno udeležbo študentov (razlaga, diskusija, vprašanja, primeri, reševanje problemov),
- seminarske vaje (pisne refleksije strokovnih člankov, timsko delo, diskusija na obravnavane tematike vezane na predmet),
- uporaba spletne učilnice oziroma drugih sodobnih IKT orodij,
- seminarske vaje, ki temeljijo na utrjevanju znanja, problemskem učenju, dodatni razlagi, diskusiji, kritičnem razpravljanju,
- individualne in skupinske konzultacije (diskusija, dodatna razlaga, obravnavanje specifičnih vprašanj).

Learning and teaching methods:

- lectures with active student participation (explanation, discussion, questions, examples, case-solving),
- seminars (written reflections on scientific articles, team work, discussing presented themes),
- use of online classroom or other contemporary ICT tools,
- tutorials based on knowledge (strengthening, problem-learning, additional explanation, discussion, critical debate),
- individual and group consultations (discussion, additional explanation, consideration of specific issues).
