Cilji in kompetence:

Cilji: so povezani s štirimi sklopi predmetnika.

Cilj prvega sklopa je posredovati znanje o različnih filozofskih konceptih o relaciji duše in telesa, spodbuditi razmišljanje o enotnosti človeških dimenzij in obenem razumeti kompleksnost teh sistemov.

Cilj drugega sklopa je posredovati znanje o razvoju psihosomatike, od psihodinamske usmeritve do sodobnega razumevanja prepletenosti duševnih in telesnih motenj.

Cilj tretjega sklopa je posredovati znanje o fiziologiji in psihologiji stresnih mehanizmov, kot osnove razvoja večine duševnih in telesnih motenj.

V tem sklopu se študentom posreduje tudi znanje o salutologiji oz. salutogenezi, o razumevanju dejavnikov, ki posameznika in skupnost ohranjajo zdravega.

Študenti bodo seznanjeni tudi s problematiko placebo in nocebo učinka, kot pomembnega dejavnika pri učinkovanju različnih terapevtskih ukrepov.

V četrtem sklopu bo študent seznanjen z značilnostmi somatizacijskih in somatoformnih motenj, tako da bodo razumeli razliko med temi motnjami.

Kompetence:

- sposobnost poglobljene kritične analize, sinteze in predvidevanja rešitev ter posledic
- sposobnost povezovanja znanja in obvladovanja kompleksnosti, s katero se srečujejo pri strokovnem delu
- zmožnost avtonomno uporabljati vire za učenje z demonstracijo spretnosti upravljanja in integriranja informacij
- sposobnost sintetizirati lastno integracijo teorije, svetovalne prakse ter izkušenj procesa osebne rasti
- poglobljena splošna raven razumevanja drugih glavnih svetovalnih pristopov.

Objectives and competences:

Objectives: They are linked to the four elements of the curriculum.

The goal of the first section is to convey knowledge regarding various philosophical concepts on the relation of soul and body, to stimulate contemplation on the unity of human dimensions and at the same time to understand the complexity of that systems.

The goal of the second section is to transfer knowledge regarding the development of psychosomatics, starting with the psychodynamic theory and ending at the modern understanding of the interdependence of mental and physical disorders.

The goal of the third section is to convey knowledge about physiology and psychology of stress mechanisms, as the basis of development of most mental and physical disorders.

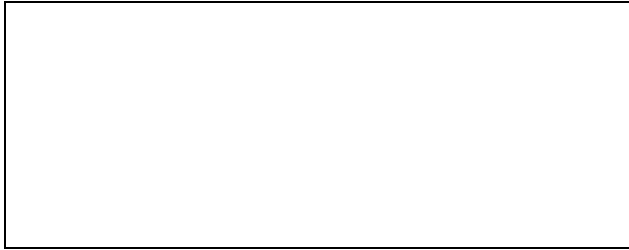
In this context, the students should receive knowledge regarding salutology and salutogenesis, as theories on the factors that keep the individuals and the community healthy.

Students should receive information regarding placebo and nocebo effect., as an important factor effecting outcome of different therapeutic measures.

In the fourth section, the students should become familiar with the characteristics of somization and somatoform disorders, to understand the difference between these topics, regarding their etiology and dynamics.

Competences:

- the ability of critical analysis, synthesis and prediction of solutions and consequences
- the ability to connect knowledge and manage complexity faced in professional work
- the ability to autonomously use resources for learning by demonstrating management skills and integration of information
- the ability to synthesize their own integration of theory, counselling practice,



and experience of the process of personal growth

- understanding of other major counselling modalities and approaches

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

- demonstrirati znanje, razumevanje in uporabo temeljnih konceptov psihosomatike in vedenjske znanosti
- razumeti in poznati kontekste, v katerih poteka diagnostika stresno pogojenih in somatizacijskih motenj
- demonstrirati kritično mišljenje in refleksijo pri ovrednotenju posameznih psihosomatskih teorij
- demonstrirati uporabo psihoterapevtske in medicinske diagnostike duševnih motenj
- integrirati različna teoretska in diagnostična spoznanja pri delu s klienti v koherentno celoto
- uporabiti teoretska in diagnostična spoznanja pri načrtovanju poteka psihosocialne pomoči in svetovanja
- demonstrirati znanje in razumevanje s področja nevrobiologije, fiziologije in psihologije stresa

Intended learning outcomes:

- demonstrate the knowledge, understanding and use of fundamental concepts of psychosomatics and behavioral science
- understand the contexts in which the diagnostics of stress induced and somatization disorders are performed
- demonstrate critical thinking and reflection in evaluation of different psychosomatic theories
- demonstrate the use of psychotherapeutic and medical diagnostics of mental disorders to integrate different theoretical concepts when working with clients
- to use theoretical and diagnostic knowledge in the planning the course of psychosocial help and counselling
- demonstrate the understanding of the field of neurobiology, physiology and psychology of stress
